

CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICY

- If for any reason you cannot attend the course and have to cancel, the first payment of 800 € is always Non- Refundable.
- If you have paid all the course fees and for any reason you have to cancel this is how the policy goes:
- If you cancel more than 6 week prior to the starting date 1000 € will be refunded
- If you cancel 6 weeks or less before the starting date you will lose the whole payment
- The course management reserves the right to ask any student to leave the programme without refund at any time should they be causing themselves or the group, harm, harassment, or disturbance, not following the yogic code of conduct or be in a fragile or unsafe state of body/mind. In which case they will be adequately supported to leave the training and get home safely)
- Once the programme has started there will be no refunds for the training

CODE OF CONDUCT / ETHICS

As a trained yoga teacher, I agree to uphold the ethical goals set forth in the following Code of Ethics and that

I shall aim to act accordingly at all time:

- As a yoga teacher I strive to live with integrity in accordance with the principles of Yoga
- To the best of my ability I adhere to the principles of yamas and niyamas of the Yoga Sutra's of Patanjali.
- I serve the interests of the community, and follow the local laws that pertain to my teaching business.
- Uphold and enhance the good standing and reputation of our profession.
- I shall teach with goodwill and respect towards all people. Welcoming, warm, compassionate and friendly to all students irrespective of age, physical limitations, race, gender, sexual orientation, religion or national origin.
- As a yoga teacher I shall guide all students with an awareness of their differing individual needs and use the knowledge and experience gained in the training as well as my continuing Yoga education to do so.
- I recognise the limitations of my knowledge and competence and make only realistic statements regarding the benefits of yoga.
- As a yoga teacher I make responsible decisions to determine if and when I can assist a student for therapy or rehabilitation through use of yogic skills and knowledge. I will recommend students to seek advice from a qualified health professional for appropriate treatment when necessary.
- I strive to be an example of cleanliness and purity of body, mind and habits. Dressing in a clean and modest manner when teaching yoga. I create a safe, clean and comfortable environment for the practice of yoga.
- I treat my work colleagues from all styles of Yoga respectfully

- I respect the rights, dignity and privacy of all student. There information is confidential and managed in a professional manner and any documentation is kept in a secure location.
- In the presence of yoga students I refrain to comment about other students
- I understand that all forms of sexual behaviour or harassment with students is unethical and only use appropriate methods of touch when assisting students. I should avoid intimate relations with my students. If the student teacher relationship is compromised by the existence of an intimate relationship, then another teacher should be sought for the student.
- I shall maintain a regular personal practice
- I seek honesty in all in all relations and interactions; financial, material, emotional and spiritual.
